Our graduate students are awarded teaching assistantships that include a **stipend** and a **tuition waiver** and give them valuable experience in French language pedagogy.

Interdisciplinary endeavors are highly valued at UIC, and our MA students may work with other programs, such as Gender and Women's Studies, Moving Image Arts, and Black Studies.

The French faculty is thrilled to welcome Rose E. Gérazime, a Francophonist. Recent exciting **events** include speakers such as Andreï Makine and Dany Laferrière of the Académie française, and playwright Valère Novarina. With the French Consulate, we also hosted the 2019 Biennale de la langue française.

The School of Literatures, Cultural Studies, and Linguistics sponsors an **annual conference**—featuring nationally prominent keynote speakers—at which faculty and graduate students present their work in progress.

GRADUATE PLACEMENT

Our graduates are regularly **accepted into top Ph.D. programs**, including the University of Chicago, Northwestern University, New York University, Duke University, and Princeton University.

Other graduates have gone on to **teach** in private and public schools, and to apply their French in the practice of **law**, **architecture**, **or business**.
