Our MA program offers solid academic and practical training in the language, literatures, and cultures of the French-speaking world. We have generous funding and welcome both full-time and part-time students. Successful graduates will be prepared for advanced academic and professional studies, as well as entry into fields such as education, international affairs, and academic administration.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Minimum Undergraduate GPA of 3.0, 2-3 letters of recommendation, a sample of written French, a phone or video interview, approval by MA director if undergraduate degree is in another discipline. Applicants must also comply with all USF admission policies including TOEFL requirements for international students from non-English-speaking countries.

APPLYING FOR A GRADUATE ASSISTANTSHIP

Qualified applicants who intend to be full-time students are encouraged to apply for a **Graduate Teaching Assistantship**.
