ADVANCED OPPORTUNITY FELLOWSHIPS (AOFs) NOW AVAILABLE

Minority, economically disadvantaged and McNair students may qualify for an Advanced Opportunity Fellowship* (AOF) that includes five years of guaranteed funding in the form of fellowships and teaching assistantships while completing the Ph.D. program in French or Italian. *Students must be United States citizens or permanent residents to qualify.

Stipends for 2023-24 AOF funding are \$30,000 for the year (August 2023—August 2024) and include paid tuition & segregated fees, a \$600 welcome payment, and eligibility for health benefits.
